



Notice of Public Information Session

St. Marys Cement is preparing the supporting documents required to obtain the necessary permits to proceed with an **Alternative Fuel Demonstration Project** later this year. The alternative fuel demonstration would substitute alternative fuel for a portion of the fossil fuel used at the Bowmanville cement plant for a few weeks, in order to gather site-specific air emission data from the plant to determine the environmental feasibility of using select alternative fuels.

The proposed alternative fuels for the demonstration are residuals from processing plants including: paper bio-solids, post-recycling residual plastics and post-composting residual plastic film.

St. Marys has identified some potential environmental benefits to using alternative fuels including: providing a viable use for residuals that would otherwise be landfilled, a sizeable reduction in the use of non-renewable fossil fuels, and a reduction in greenhouse gas emissions.

St. Marys is hosting two public information sessions, to provide you an opportunity to review preliminary information regarding the Alternative Fuel Demonstration Project and to speak directly with the project team members.
