Bottom line: Every facility needs an Acoustic Assessment Report (AAR) to demonstrate that it meets Provincial noise limits






Timeline of Actions

- 2011 Retained HGC Engineering
- 2011 Noise measurements conducted
- 2012 Acoustic Assessment Report completed submitted to the Ministry of the Environment
- 2015 Updated Acoustic Assessment Report and application
- 2017 Environmental Compliance Approval issued by the Ministry
- 2017 to present implementation of Noise Abatement Action Plan

Acoustic Assessment Report (AAR)





Noise Abatement Action Plan

Stage	Timeline	Action Item
Stage 1	2 years	Redesign of Secondary Crusher Building Dryer plant silencer
Stage 2	4 years	Acoustic silencer for Main Kiln Stack Acoustic silencers for six baghouse exhausts
Stage 3	6 years	Acoustic silencers for 17 baghouse exhausts Acoustic enclosures for two pressure blowers and kiln motor Installation of several dedicated blowers for unloading cement trucks
Stage 4	8 years	Acoustic silencers for 23 kiln shell cooling fans
Stage 5	10 years	Replacement Clinker Cooler Fans Four acoustic silencers and three enclosures – miscellaneous
