

## **Attention Canadian Customers**

## Fuel Surcharge Applicable to Delivered Loads (\$ Cdn)

Please read carefully as, effective December 1st, the metrics will change.

- The trigger for a fuel surcharge will be if the average monthly fuel price surpasses \$1.15/L.
- The amount of the fuel surcharge will be established on a monthly basis, based on an average of the prior four-week period.
- The surcharge applicable is \$0.07/t for every cent over the threshold (used to be \$0.15).

For example, using the month of February 2022 to illustrate, the average fuel price according to the Freight Carrier Association of Canada is \$1.386/L for the month of February, which means a \$3.54/t fuel surcharge would be invoiced on all volume delivered in March.

(1.386 - 1.150 (threshold)) = \$0.236 difference

23.6 cents x \$0.07/cent = \$1.65

## **Current Fuel Surcharge**

Here is the current surcharge and the weekly values, per Freight Carrier Association of Canada, used to calculate the surcharge:

0	Average of the last 4 weeks	1.414
•	Week of November 25	1.431
•	Week of November 18	1.441
•	Week of November 11	1.401
•	Week of November 4	1.386

## Calculation of the Fuel Surcharge

1.414 - 1.150 = \$0.264 difference  $2.64 \times \$0.07$ /cent = \$1.84
