**2. Community Complaints including Historical Odour and Dust Complaint Process**

The total number of complaints 2026 YTD was presented.

Reminder; Complaints that 'Mention Health' are counted when a resident calls with an odour complaint and highlights that they have a health concern. They are not separate complaints received by the plant.

Reviewed odour complaints, dust complaints, blasting complaints.

**3. Alternative Low Carbon Fuels Update**

St Marys Cement reviewed quantities of fuels used since starting ALCF in 2024 and highlighted equivalent quantities for frame of reference.

**4. Formation of Limestone and Limestone Quality for Cement Manufacturing**

St Marys Cement reviewed the formation of limestone in the St Marys Area and the varying quality parameters required for cement manufacturing.

Jim inquired about limestone reserves in the St Marys Cement quarry. St Marys Cement noted 70 years worth of limestone.
