No comments or concerns were brought forward about the June 5th meeting.

2. Community Complaints including Historical Odour and Dust Complaint Process

The total number of complaints 2026 YTD was presented.

SMC reviewed odour and dust complaint process and complaints received YTD on site.

Reminder; Complaints that 'Mention Health' are counted when a resident calls with an odour complaint and highlights that they have a health concern. They are not separate complaints received by the plant.

Reviewed odour complaints, dust complaints, blasting complaints.

3. Alternative Low Carbon Fuels Update

St Marys Cement reviewed quantities of fuels used since starting ALCF in 2024 and highlighted equivalent quantities for frame of reference.

4. Terms of Reference

The Terms of Reference are due to be reviewed and with the addition of new council members there is potential for modifying clauses within the terms of reference. The TOR will be reviewed at the December CLC including clauses around format of meetings, frequency, membership, and proactive vernacular.

Fred noted reduction in smell in the last few months.

Jim wondered about the required frequency of CLC meetings, and about frequency of number of complaints for individual complaints.

Brian wondered if the odour is less prevalent or if he was becoming immune, and noted he was a repeat concerned resident.

Jim noted there are tests we can do for individual sensitivity to odour.

Alejandro noted there are various projects being implemented on site that are working towards continuing environmental performance.
